Interim Clerk Nickel and Utility Supervisor Whetstine were also present. Members of the community including Andrew and Elizabeth Miller, Marcy DeJonge and Sara Hammond were also in attendance. Posted notices in three public places within the village. Notice of meeting and agenda was given to Trustees in advance. As required by law Chairman Moninger, pointed out the copy of the Opens Meeting Act posted on the wall for public viewing and called the meeting to order. Proceedings shown were taken while convened meeting was open to the public.

There were no votes against the motion. Motion carried. Marcy DeJonge discussed the upcoming Spring Circle Drive Market to be held on May 23rd. The Village will provide a porta-potty. Discussion was held regarding the opening for a Village Clerk. We will renew the ad in Franklin and Harlan County papers. A motion was made by Eddy, seconded by Einspahr to compensate the interim clerk at a wage of \$29/hr. Voting Aye: Eddy, Einspahr, Moninger and Pokaluk. There were no votes against the motion. Motion carried.
