The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees was held April 6, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. at the Fire Hall with Trustees Eddy, Einspahr, Moninger, and Pokaluk present. Interim Clerk Nickel and Utility Supervisor Whetstine were also present. Posted notices in three public places within the village. Notice of meeting and agenda was given to Trustees in advance. As required by law Chairman Moninger, pointed out the copy of the Opens Meeting Act posted on the wall for public viewing and called the meeting to order. Proceedings shown were taken while convened meeting was open to the public.

The meeting was brought to order by Moninger at 5:30 P.M.

Motion by Moninger, seconded by Einspahr, to approve the minutes from the March 2, 2026 meeting. Voting Aye: Eddy, Einspahr, Moninger and Pokaluk. There were no votes against the motion. Motion carried.

Motion by Einspahr, seconded by Pokaluk to pay the following bills:

Motion carried. Clerk to notify appropriate parties. The annual audit was reviewed. Clerk to contact several local CPA firms for bids for future audits. We are still waiting for quote on Speed Bumps. A motion by Eddy, seconded by Pokaluk to approve up to \$1,000.00 to the City of Franklin for seasonal mosquito spraying. Voting Aye: Eddy, Einspahr, Moninger and Pokaluk. There were no votes against the Motion. A motion by Eddy, seconded by Pokaluk to pay Linda's Greenhouse up to \$400.00 to replant the Village flower pots. Voting Aye: Eddy, Einspahr, Moninger and Pokaluk. There were no votes against the Motion. Motion carried. A discussion was held regarding use of firehall water. The Utility Superintendent will use his discretion for single use under 1,000 gallons. A motion was made by Einspahr, seconded by Eddy to offer Tana Goosic \$29.00/hr. to maintain the Village website. Voting Aye: Eddy, Einspahr, Moninger and Pokaluk. There were no votes against the motion. Motion carried. There have been no applicants for the Village Clerk opening. Clerk to re-run newspaper ads.
